Family Fireworks Safety Information

Family Fireworks are not toys and must be treated with respect!

Obey the laws and by-laws for buying, storing and using Fireworks in your town.





Keep fireworks in a cool dry, ventilated place away from children.



Choose a wide, clear site away from obstacles (30m x 30m).



Keep water nearby to dispose of debris & used fireworks.





Bury fireworks that do not have a standing base halfway, unless the label indicates otherwise.



Use a good firing base or a wheelbarrow, filled with earth or sand.



Never light a firework in your hand or hold a lighted firework in your hand, other than a sparkler.





Do not fire in windy conditions.



Light carefully. Always light the fuse at its tip.



Never try to relight a firework that did not go off. Never try to fix a defective firework. Wait at least 30 minutes before approaching the firework.

More Safety Information

To buy Family Fireworks you must be 18 years old.

No smoking or drinking around Fireworks.

Do not transport Fireworks in the passenger compartment of a vehicle, use the trunk.

You can store a maximum of 10 kg gross weight of Fireworks in your house.

Wear non-flammable clothing such as cotton when igniting Fireworks. Don't use synthetic fibers (nylon, polyester)

Never put any part of your body or head over the Fireworks when you are igniting them.

Keep Fireworks in a closed container or box.

Always use Fireworks outdoors.
